Fuchsias, Bacopas, Bidens and Diascias



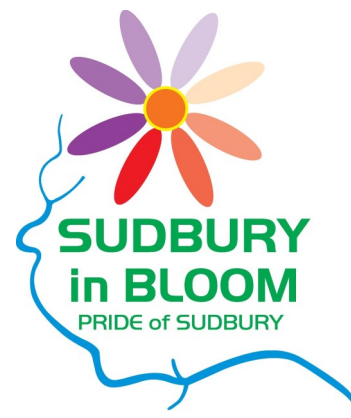
FOR BUTTERFLIES
