

HOW TO GROW IN POTS

GROWING TIPS

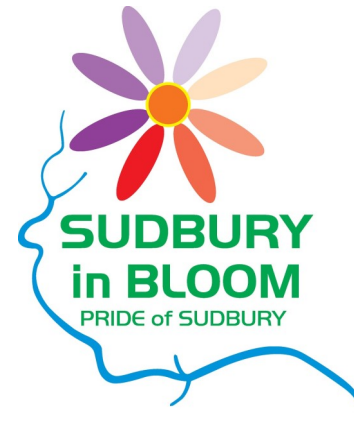
All sorts of items can be repurposed as planters – get creative! Just make sure there are drainage holes in the bottom so the soil doesn't get waterlogged and cause the plant to rot.

Remember **the roots of a plant are as important as the bits above ground** – make sure they have all the room they need to grow and thrive.

Use a good multipurpose compost

– there are lots of decent peat-free alternatives now. Fertilise regularly in summer – plants need food!

Make sure you water regularly. Poke a finger in the compost – if you don't feel moisture under the surface it's time to water!

HERBS

A mixture of herbs can look great in a planter—just make sure the flavours go well together! Keep mints separate: they are thugs!

ALPINES

Garden in miniature! Small but tough, alpines and succulents can be planted in shallow troughs and bowls, and don't need much watering.

AND THE REST!

Try ferns and ornamental grasses. Some shrubs, roses, climbers and trees are much better suited to pots than most others—look for varieties described as "patio" or "dwarf". "Vigorous" plants will outgrow their pots too quickly.
